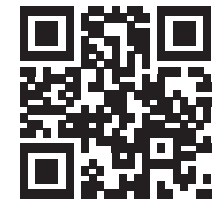

After the artwork is approved, it takes approximately 4-8 weeks to receive your coins.

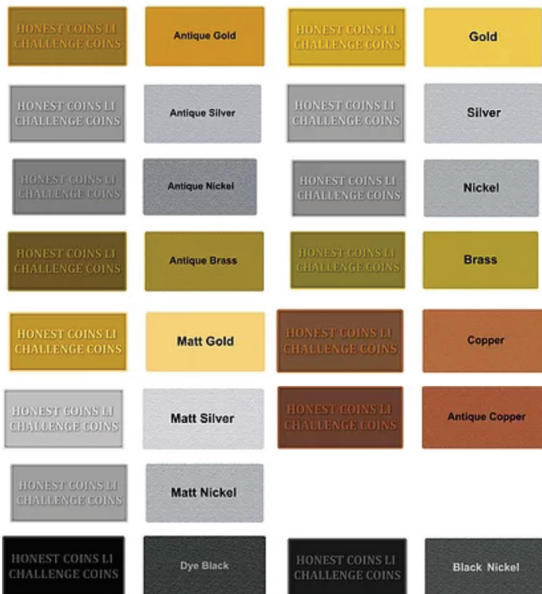
Do you offer rush/expedited service?

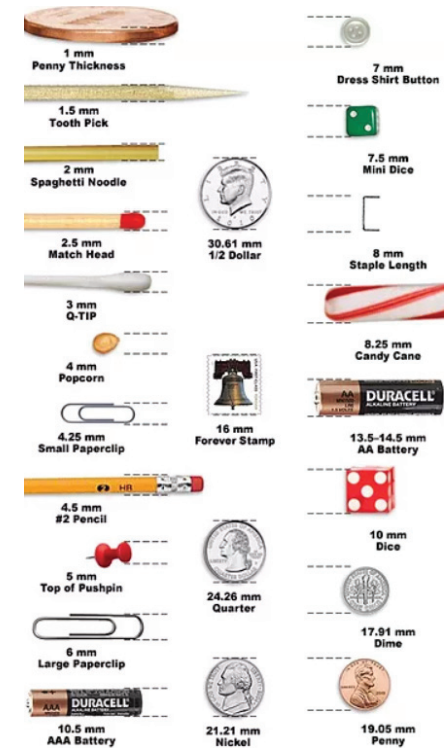

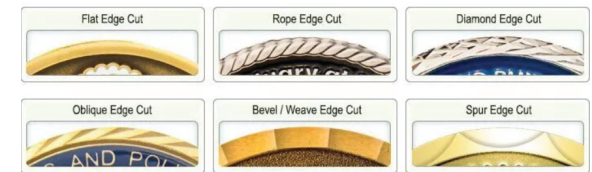
What are the different surfaces of a challenge?

- **Flat** - No raised and recessed surface area.
- **2D** - Two levels of metal, both raised and recessed areas.
- **3D** - More prominent raised and recessed areas of metal, changing the look, feel, and weight of the coin.
- **3D Raised** - The most prominent raised and recessed areas of metal, changing the look, feel, and weight of the coin.
- **UV Print** - A printing process in which ink is dried and cured under a ultraviolet light. The printing ink contains photosensitizer and the coin is set with a UV- cured lamp.
- **UV 3D Print** - combines both 3D, and UV print.
